TRUE/FALSE QUESTIONS ASSESS STUDENTS' ABILITY TO EVALUATE STATEMENTS ABOUT HISTORICAL FACTS OR INTERPRETATIONS QUICKLY. THESE REQUIRE CAREFUL READING TO AVOID COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS OR TRAPS.

SHORT ANSWER AND ESSAY QUESTIONS

SHORT ANSWER QUESTIONS DEMAND CONCISE EXPLANATIONS OR IDENTIFICATION OF SIGNIFICANT PEOPLE, EVENTS, OR IDEAS. ESSAY QUESTIONS, WHEN INCLUDED, CHALLENGE STUDENTS TO CONSTRUCT WELL-ORGANIZED ARGUMENTS AND DEMONSTRATE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF HISTORICAL THEMES.

DOCUMENT-BASED QUESTIONS (DBQs)

SOME QUIZZES INCORPORATE DBQs, WHERE STUDENTS ANALYZE EXCERPTS FROM PRIMARY SOURCES SUCH AS SPEECHES, LETTERS, OR LEGISLATIVE ACTS. THIS FORMAT ENCOURAGES CRITICAL THINKING AND CONTEXTUAL ANALYSIS.
