REGIONAL DIVISIONS OF THE 13 COLONIES

MIDDLE COLONIES

RHODE ISLAND

FOUNDED BY ROGER WILLIAMS IN 1636 AS A REFUGE FOR RELIGIOUS DISSENTERS, RHODE ISLAND WAS KNOWN FOR ITS RELIGIOUS TOLERANCE AND SEPARATION OF CHURCH AND STATE.

CONNECTICUT

ESTABLISHED IN THE 1630S, CONNECTICUT WAS NOTABLE FOR ITS EARLY ADOPTION OF A WRITTEN CONSTITUTION, THE FUNDAMENTAL ORDERS, WHICH INFLUENCED AMERICAN CONSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT.

NEW YORK

ORIGINALLY SETTLED BY THE DUTCH AS NEW AMSTERDAM, IT WAS TAKEN BY THE ENGLISH IN 1664 AND RENAMED NEW YORK. IT BECAME A MAJOR TRADING HUB DUE TO ITS STRATEGIC LOCATION.

NEW JERSEY

NEW JERSEY WAS ORIGINALLY PART OF NEW YORK BUT BECAME A SEPARATE COLONY IN 1664. IT ATTRACTED A DIVERSE POPULATION AND DEVELOPED AGRICULTURE AND TRADE.

PENNSYLVANIA

FOUNDED BY WILLIAM PENN IN 1681 AS A QUAKER COLONY, PENNSYLVANIA WAS KNOWN FOR ITS RELIGIOUS FREEDOM, GOOD RELATIONS WITH NATIVE AMERICANS, AND FERTILE LAND.

DELAWARE

DELAWARE WAS INITIALLY PART OF PENNSYLVANIA BUT BECAME A SEPARATE COLONY IN 1704. IT WAS AN IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL PRODUCER AND TRADING CENTER.

MARYLAND

ESTABLISHED IN 1632 AS A REFUGE FOR ENGLISH CATHOLICS, MARYLAND HAD A TOBACCO-BASED ECONOMY AND A POLICY OF RELIGIOUS TOLERANCE FOR CHRISTIANS.

VIRGINIA

FOUNDED IN 1607 WITH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF JAMESTOWN, VIRGINIA WAS THE FIRST PERMANENT ENGLISH SETTLEMENT AND BECAME THE LARGEST AND MOST POPULOUS COLONY WITH A PLANTATION ECONOMY.

NORTH CAROLINA

NORTH CAROLINA WAS SETTLED BY VIRGINIANS SEEKING NEW LAND. IT DEVELOPED A LESS ARISTOCRATIC SOCIETY FOCUSED ON SMALL-SCALE FARMING AND TRADE.

SOUTH CAROLINA

SOUTH CAROLINA WAS FOUNDED IN 1670 AND DEVELOPED LARGE PLANTATIONS GROWING RICE AND INDIGO, RELYING HEAVILY ON ENSLAVED LABOR.

GEORGIA

FOUNDED IN 1733 AS A DEBTOR'S COLONY AND BUFFER AGAINST SPANISH FLORIDA, GEORGIA HAD STRICT INITIAL REGULATIONS BUT LATER DEVELOPED INTO A PLANTATION ECONOMY.
