THE ORIGINS OF AMERICAN GOVERNMENT

IT OFTEN INCLUDES THE STUDY OF ENLIGHTENMENT THINKERS SUCH AS JOHN LOCKE AND MONTESQUIEU, WHOSE IDEAS INFLUENCED THE FOUNDING FATHERS. THE TEST MAY ALSO COVER THE COLONIAL EXPERIENCE, THE ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION, AND THE REASONS FOR DRAFTING THE CONSTITUTION.

THE CONSTITUTION AND ITS STRUCTURE

THIS PRINCIPLE IS CRITICAL FOR MAINTAINING THE BALANCE OF POWER WITHIN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

CHECKS AND BALANCES

CHECKS AND BALANCES ARE MECHANISMS THAT ALLOW EACH BRANCH TO MONITOR AND LIMIT THE POWERS OF THE OTHERS. EXAMPLES INCLUDE THE PRESIDENTIAL VETO, CONGRESSIONAL OVERSIGHT, AND JUDICIAL REVIEW. THIS SYSTEM ENSURES ACCOUNTABILITY AND PREVENTS ABUSES OF POWER.

FEDERALISM

FEDERALISM REFERS TO THE DIVISION OF POWER BETWEEN THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AND THE STATES. IT ALLOWS FOR A

BALANCE BETWEEN UNITY AND REGIONAL AUTONOMY. UNDERSTANDING THE NUANCES OF FEDERALISM IS ESSENTIAL FOR GRASPING HOW LAWS AND POLICIES ARE IMPLEMENTED ACROSS DIFFERENT LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT.

WHAT ARE THE KEY PRINCIPLES OUTLINED IN THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE?

THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE EMPHASIZES NATURAL RIGHTS (LIFE, LIBERTY, AND THE PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS), THE SOCIAL CONTRACT, POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY, AND THE RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE TO OVERTHROW A GOVERNMENT THAT VIOLATES THEIR RIGHTS.

HOW DOES THE CONSTITUTION ESTABLISH THE FRAMEWORK FOR FEDERALISM?

THE CONSTITUTION ESTABLISHES FEDERALISM BY DIVIDING POWER BETWEEN THE NATIONAL AND STATE GOVERNMENTS, WITH CERTAIN POWERS DELEGATED TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, OTHERS RESERVED TO THE STATES, AND SOME SHARED CONCURRENTLY.

HOW DOES THE SYSTEM OF CHECKS AND BALANCES WORK IN THE US GOVERNMENT?

CHECKS AND BALANCES ALLOW EACH BRANCH OF GOVERNMENT (LEGISLATIVE, EXECUTIVE, JUDICIAL) TO LIMIT THE POWERS OF THE OTHERS, ENSURING NO SINGLE BRANCH BECOMES TOO POWERFUL. FOR EXAMPLE, THE PRESIDENT CAN VETO LEGISLATION, CONGRESS CAN OVERRIDE VETOES, AND THE SUPREME COURT CAN DECLARE LAWS UNCONSTITUTIONAL.

FEDERALIST NO. 10 ADDRESSES THE DANGERS OF FACTIONS AND ADVOCATES FOR A LARGE REPUBLIC TO CONTROL THEM, WHILE FEDERALIST NO. 51 EXPLAINS THE NEED FOR CHECKS AND BALANCES AND SEPARATION OF POWERS TO PREVENT TYRANNY.
