KEY CONCEPTS AND FORMULAS IN CHAPTER 9

LEAST-SQUARES REGRESSION LINE (LSRL)

THE LSRL IS THE LINE THAT BEST FITS THE OBSERVED DATA POINTS BY MINIMIZING THE SUM OF THE SQUARED RESIDUALS. IT IS EXPRESSED AS:

$$\hat{y} = b_0 + b_1x \text{ WHERE } b_0 \text{ IS THE INTERCEPT AND } b_1 \text{ IS THE SLOPE OF THE LINE.}$$

HYPOTHESIS TESTING FOR THE SLOPE

HYPOTHESIS TESTS IN CHAPTER 9 TYPICALLY EVALUATE WHETHER THE SLOPE OF THE POPULATION REGRESSION LINE (β_1) IS ZERO, INDICATING NO LINEAR RELATIONSHIP.

- **NULL HYPOTHESIS (H_0):** $\beta_1 = 0$
- **ALTERNATIVE HYPOTHESIS (H_a):** $\beta_1 \neq 0$ (OR $\beta_1 > 0$, $\beta_1 < 0$ DEPENDING ON CONTEXT)

THE TEST STATISTIC IS CALCULATED USING:

$$t = (b_1 - 0) / SE(b_1), \text{ WHERE } SE(b_1) \text{ IS THE STANDARD ERROR OF THE SLOPE.}$$

CONFIDENCE INTERVALS FOR THE SLOPE

A $(1 - \alpha)100\%$ CONFIDENCE INTERVAL FOR THE SLOPE IS GIVEN BY:

$$b_1 \pm t^* \times SE(b_1), \text{ WHERE } t^* \text{ IS THE CRITICAL VALUE FROM THE T-DISTRIBUTION WITH } (n - 2) \text{ DEGREES OF FREEDOM.}$$

CONDITIONS FOR INFERENCE

BEFORE PERFORMING INFERENCE, IT IS IMPORTANT TO VERIFY THE FOLLOWING ASSUMPTIONS:

1. **LINEARITY:** THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN VARIABLES IS LINEAR.
2. **INDEPENDENCE:** OBSERVATIONS ARE INDEPENDENT OF EACH OTHER.
3. **NORMALITY:** RESIDUALS ARE APPROXIMATELY NORMALLY DISTRIBUTED.
4. **EQUAL VARIANCE (HOMOSCEDASTICITY):** THE VARIANCE OF RESIDUALS IS CONSTANT ACROSS VALUES OF THE EXPLANATORY VARIABLE.

COMMON QUESTION TYPES ON THE CHAPTER 9 AP STATS TEST
