OVERVIEW OF SPANISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES

SPANISH, OR ESPAÑOL, IS ONE OF THE MOST WIDELY SPOKEN LANGUAGES IN THE WORLD, WITH OVER 460 MILLION NATIVE SPEAKERS. THE MAJORITY OF SPANISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES ARE LOCATED IN LATIN AMERICA, WHERE SPANISH WAS INTRODUCED DURING THE COLONIAL PERIOD. ADDITIONALLY, SPAIN IN EUROPE IS THE ORIGIN OF THE SPANISH LANGUAGE, ADDING HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE TO THE LIST OF COUNTRIES AND CAPITALS OF SPANISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES. - **DOMINICAN REPUBLIC** – SANTO DOMINGO: THE OLDEST CONTINUOUSLY INHABITED EUROPEAN SETTLEMENT IN THE AMERICAS.
- **COLOMBIA** – BOGOTÁ : LOCATED HIGH IN THE ANDES, BOGOTÁ IS COLOMBIA’S ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL CAPITAL.
- **VENEZUELA** – CARACAS: KNOWN FOR ITS OIL INDUSTRY, CARACAS SERVES AS VENEZUELA’S POLITICAL CENTER.
- **ECUADOR** – QUITO: FAMOUS FOR ITS WELL-PRESERVED COLONIAL CENTER, QUITO LIES NEAR THE EQUATOR.
- **PERU** – LIMA: A COASTAL METROPOLIS, LIMA IS THE POLITICAL, CULTURAL, AND ECONOMIC CAPITAL OF PERU.
- **BOLIVIA** – SUCRE (CONSTITUTIONAL CAPITAL) AND LA PAZ (ADMINISTRATIVE CAPITAL): BOLIVIA UNIQUELY HAS TWO CAPITALS SERVING DIFFERENT GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTIONS.
- **PARAGUAY** – ASUNCIÓN: ONE OF THE OLDEST CITIES IN SOUTH AMERICA AND THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT FOR PARAGUAY.
- **CHILE** – SANTIAGO: NESTLED IN A VALLEY SURROUNDED BY THE ANDES, SANTIAGO IS CHILE’S ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL CENTER.
- **ARGENTINA** – BUENOS AIRES: KNOWN FOR ITS EUROPEAN-STYLE ARCHITECTURE AND VIBRANT ARTS SCENE, BUENOS AIRES IS A MAJOR GLOBAL CITY.
- **URUGUAY** – MONTEVIDEO: A PORT CITY WITH A RICH CULTURAL HERITAGE AND THE ECONOMIC HUB OF URUGUAY.

UNIQUE CAPITAL FEATURES

SEVERAL CAPITALS IN LATIN AMERICA HAVE UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS. FOR EXAMPLE, BOLIVIA’S DUAL-CAPITAL SYSTEM IS RARE GLOBALLY, WITH SUCRE BEING THE CONSTITUTIONAL CAPITAL AND LA PAZ HOUSING THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES. SIMILARLY, PANAMA CITY’S SIGNIFICANCE IS HEIGHTENED BY THE PRESENCE OF THE PANAMA CANAL, WHICH IS VITAL FOR INTERNATIONAL MARITIME TRADE.

SPANISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES IN EUROPE

EUROPE IS HOME TO SPAIN, THE ORIGIN OF THE SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE. SPAIN'S CAPITAL IS MADRID, A CITY KNOWN FOR ITS HISTORICAL LANDMARKS, ART MUSEUMS, AND POLITICAL IMPORTANCE. OTHER SPANISH SPEAKING TERRITORIES

IN ADDITION TO INDEPENDENT COUNTRIES, SEVERAL TERRITORIES AND REGIONS RECOGNIZE SPANISH AS AN OFFICIAL LANGUAGE OR HAVE SIGNIFICANT SPANISH SPEAKING POPULATIONS. THESE AREAS OFTEN HAVE THEIR OWN CAPITALS OR ADMINISTRATIVE CENTERS THAT CONTRIBUTE TO THE BROADER SPANISH SPEAKING WORLD.

SPANISH SPEAKING TERRITORIES AND THEIR CENTERS

- **PUERTO RICO** – SAN JUAN: A U.S. TERRITORY WITH SPANISH AS AN OFFICIAL LANGUAGE AND A CAPITAL KNOWN FOR ITS HISTORIC FORTS AND VIBRANT CULTURE.
- **EQUATORIAL GUINEA** – MALABO: LOCATED IN AFRICA, EQUATORIAL GUINEA IS THE ONLY AFRICAN COUNTRY WHERE SPANISH IS AN OFFICIAL LANGUAGE, AND MALABO SERVES AS ITS CAPITAL.
- **WESTERN SAHARA** – LAAYOUNE (CLAIMED): SPANISH IS SPOKEN DUE TO HISTORICAL TIES, AND LAAYOUNE IS THE LARGEST CITY AND ADMINISTRATIVE CENTER.

SIGNIFICANCE OF THESE TERRITORIES
