AIRWAY MANAGEMENT AND BREATHING

AIRWAY MANAGEMENT IS A FUNDAMENTAL SKILL FOR EMTs, ENSURING PATIENTS MAINTAIN ADEQUATE OXYGENATION. QUESTIONS RELATED TO AIRWAY ASSESSMENT, OBSTRUCTION CLEARANCE, AND VENTILATION TECHNIQUES ARE COMMON IN EMT EXAMS. MASTERY OF THESE TOPICS IS CRITICAL FOR EFFECTIVE EMERGENCY CARE.

COMMON AIRWAY-RELATED QUESTIONS

TYPICAL QUESTIONS MAY INCLUDE:

- HOW TO RECOGNIZE AIRWAY OBSTRUCTION IN A PATIENT.
- STEPS TO OPEN AN AIRWAY USING TECHNIQUES LIKE THE HEAD-TILT, CHIN-LIFT OR JAW-THRUST MANEUVER.

UNDERSTANDING THESE CONCEPTS ENSURES EMTs CAN RAPIDLY ASSESS AND MANAGE COMPROMISED AIRWAYS.

PATIENT ASSESSMENT PROCEDURES

COMPREHENSIVE PATIENT ASSESSMENT IS VITAL IN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES. EMT QUESTIONS OFTEN FOCUS ON STRUCTURED ASSESSMENT PROTOCOLS, IDENTIFYING LIFE-THREATENING CONDITIONS, AND PRIORITIZING INTERVENTIONS. THE ASSESSMENT PROCESS INCLUDES PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SURVEYS, VITAL SIGNS MEASUREMENT, AND HISTORY TAKING.

KEY COMPONENTS OF PATIENT ASSESSMENT

THE PRIMARY SURVEY FOCUSES ON IMMEDIATE LIFE THREATS:

- **AIRWAY:** IS IT PATENT OR OBSTRUCTED?
- **BREATHING:** IS THE PATIENT BREATHING ADEQUATELY?
- **CIRCULATION:** CHECK PULSE, BLEEDING, AND SKIN CONDITION.
- **DISABILITY:** ASSESS NEUROLOGICAL STATUS USING AVPU (ALERT, VERBAL, PAIN, UNRESPONSIVE).
- **EXPOSURE:** LOOK FOR INJURIES OR MEDICAL ALERTS.

THE SECONDARY SURVEY INCLUDES A HEAD-TO-TOE EXAMINATION AND PATIENT HISTORY GATHERING USING THE SAMPLE ACRONYM (SIGNS/SYMPTOMS, ALLERGIES, MEDICATIONS, PAST MEDICAL HISTORY, LAST ORAL INTAKE, EVENTS LEADING UP TO ILLNESS/INJURY).

EMERGENCY MEDICAL PROCEDURES AND PROTOCOLS

EMTs MUST BE FAMILIAR WITH A VARIETY OF EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND PROTOCOLS DESIGNED TO STABILIZE PATIENTS BEFORE HOSPITAL ARRIVAL. QUESTIONS IN THIS AREA TEST KNOWLEDGE ON TRAUMA CARE, CARDIAC EMERGENCIES, BLEEDING CONTROL, AND MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION WITHIN EMT SCOPE OF PRACTICE.

EXAMPLES OF PROCEDURAL QUESTIONS

COMMON PROCEDURAL TOPICS INCLUDE:

- STEPS TO CONTROL SEVERE BLEEDING USING DIRECT PRESSURE, DRESSINGS, AND TOURNIQUETS.
- MANAGEMENT OF SHOCK, INCLUDING POSITIONING AND OXYGEN THERAPY.
- RECOGNITION AND INITIAL TREATMENT OF CARDIAC EMERGENCIES SUCH AS CHEST PAIN AND CARDIAC ARREST.
- PROTOCOLS FOR ADMINISTERING OXYGEN AND ASSISTING WITH PRESCRIBED MEDICATIONS LIKE EPINEPHRINE AUTO-INJECTORS.

PROFICIENCY IN THESE PROTOCOLS ENSURES TIMELY AND EFFECTIVE PRE-HOSPITAL CARE.

MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY AND ANATOMY

UNDERSTANDING MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY AND HUMAN ANATOMY IS ESSENTIAL FOR INTERPRETING PATIENT INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATING WITH HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS. EMT QUESTIONS OFTEN TEST FAMILIARITY WITH TERMS RELATED TO BODY SYSTEMS, CONDITIONS, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL CONCEPTS.

IMPORTANT TERMINOLOGY AND ANATOMY TOPICS

KEY AREAS INCLUDE:

- BASIC ANATOMICAL TERMS SUCH AS ANTERIOR, POSTERIOR, LATERAL, MEDIAL.
- MAJOR BODY SYSTEMS INCLUDING RESPIRATORY, CARDIOVASCULAR, NERVOUS, AND MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEMS.
- COMMON MEDICAL PREFIXES, SUFFIXES, AND ABBREVIATIONS USED IN EMERGENCY CARE.

1. A PATIENT EXPERIENCING ANAPHYLAXIS REQUIRING RAPID INTERVENTION.
2. A TRAUMA VICTIM WITH SUSPECTED SPINAL INJURY NEEDING IMMOBILIZATION.
3. A DIABETIC PATIENT PRESENTING WITH ALTERED MENTAL STATUS.

4. A CARDIAC ARREST REQUIRING IMMEDIATE CPR AND DEFIBRILLATION.

THESE QUESTIONS EVALUATE THE EMT'S ABILITY TO ASSESS, DECIDE, AND ACT EFFECTIVELY IN DYNAMIC ENVIRONMENTS.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT ARE THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES OF AN EMT DURING AN EMERGENCY CALL?

THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES OF AN EMT DURING AN EMERGENCY CALL INCLUDE ASSESSING THE PATIENT'S CONDITION, PROVIDING BASIC LIFE SUPPORT, ADMINISTERING CPR, CONTROLLING BLEEDING, MANAGING AIRWAY AND BREATHING, SPLINTING FRACTURES, AND SAFELY TRANSPORTING THE PATIENT TO A MEDICAL FACILITY.

WHAT IS THE ABCs OF PATIENT ASSESSMENT IN EMT PRACTICE?

THE ABCs STAND FOR AIRWAY, BREATHING, AND CIRCULATION. EMTs MUST ENSURE THE AIRWAY IS CLEAR, ASSESS THE PATIENT'S BREATHING, AND CHECK CIRCULATION TO DETERMINE THE SEVERITY OF THE PATIENT'S CONDITION AND PROVIDE APPROPRIATE CARE.

HOW DO EMTs MANAGE A PATIENT WITH SUSPECTED SPINAL INJURY?

EMTs SHOULD IMMOBILIZE THE PATIENT'S SPINE USING A CERVICAL COLLAR AND BACKBOARD, AVOID UNNECESSARY MOVEMENT, MAINTAIN IN-LINE STABILIZATION OF THE HEAD AND NECK, AND CAREFULLY TRANSPORT THE PATIENT TO PREVENT FURTHER INJURY.

WHAT ARE THE COMMON SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF A HEART ATTACK THAT EMTs LOOK FOR?

COMMON SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS INCLUDE CHEST PAIN OR DISCOMFORT, PAIN RADIATING TO THE ARM OR JAW, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, SWEATING, NAUSEA, DIZZINESS, AND WEAKNESS. EMTs ALSO MONITOR VITAL SIGNS AND PROVIDE OXYGEN THERAPY AS NEEDED.

HOW DO EMTs PERFORM CPR ON AN ADULT PATIENT?

EMTs PERFORM CPR BY PLACING THE HEEL OF ONE HAND ON THE CENTER OF THE CHEST, PLACING THE OTHER HAND ON TOP, AND DELIVERING CHEST COMPRESSIONS AT A DEPTH OF ABOUT 2 INCHES AND A RATE OF 100-120 COMPRESSIONS PER MINUTE, ALLOWING FULL CHEST RECOIL BETWEEN COMPRESSIONS, COMBINED WITH RESCUE BREATHS IF TRAINED AND EQUIPPED.

WHAT PROTOCOLS DO EMTs FOLLOW WHEN ADMINISTERING MEDICATIONS?

EMTs FOLLOW PROTOCOLS THAT INCLUDE VERIFYING THE MEDICATION, DOSAGE, PATIENT ALLERGIES, AND INDICATION, OBTAINING CONSENT IF POSSIBLE, MONITORING THE PATIENT FOR ADVERSE REACTIONS, AND DOCUMENTING THE ADMINISTRATION ACCURATELY ACCORDING TO LOCAL MEDICAL GUIDELINES.

HOW DO EMTs HANDLE A PATIENT EXPERIENCING AN ALLERGIC REACTION OR ANAPHYLAXIS?

EMTs ASSESS AIRWAY, BREATHING, AND CIRCULATION, ADMINISTER EPINEPHRINE VIA AUTO-INJECTOR IF INDICATED, PROVIDE OXYGEN THERAPY, MONITOR VITAL SIGNS, AND PREPARE FOR RAPID TRANSPORT TO THE HOSPITAL FOR FURTHER TREATMENT.
