UNDERSTANDING PERENNIALISM IN EDUCATION

INSTEAD, PERENNIALISM VALUES THE STUDY OF CLASSICAL LITERATURE, PHILOSOPHY, MATHEMATICS, AND SCIENCES THAT PROVIDE A FOUNDATION FOR CRITICAL THINKING AND MORAL DEVELOPMENT. UNDERSTANDING THE FRAMEWORK OF PERENNIALISM IS ESSENTIAL FOR GRASPING ITS EXAMPLES AND APPLICATIONS WITHIN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS WORLDWIDE.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF PERENNIALISM

PHILOSOPHICAL FOUNDATIONS

USE OF SOCRATIC SEMINARS

SOCRATIC SEMINARS ARE A PRACTICAL EXAMPLE OF PERENNIALISM'S PEDAGOGICAL METHODS. THIS INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGY ENCOURAGES STUDENTS TO ENGAGE IN THOUGHTFUL DIALOGUE ABOUT SIGNIFICANT TEXTS AND IDEAS, PROMOTING CRITICAL THINKING AND DEEP COMPREHENSION. EMPHASIS ON CRITICAL THINKING SKILLS
