WHAT IS FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE?

FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE INVOLVES USING WORDS OR EXPRESSIONS THAT DIFFER FROM THEIR LITERAL INTERPRETATION TO CREATE VIVID IMAGERY OR EMPHASIZE PARTICULAR IDEAS. IT OFTEN RELIES ON SYMBOLISM AND ANALOGY TO EVOKE EMOTIONS OR PROVIDE DEEPER MEANING. FOR EXAMPLE, SAYING "TIME IS A THIEF" DOES NOT MEAN TIME LITERALLY STEALS BUT SUGGESTS THAT TIME CAN TAKE AWAY MOMENTS OF LIFE STEALTHILY. SUCH USAGE STIMULATES THE READER'S IMAGINATION AND HELPS COMMUNICATE COMPLEX OR SUBTLE IDEAS EFFECTIVELY.

WHAT IS LITERAL LANGUAGE?

LITERAL LANGUAGE IS STRAIGHTFORWARD AND DIRECT, WHERE WORDS MEAN EXACTLY WHAT THEY SAY. IT IS THE PRIMARY MODE OF COMMUNICATION IN FACTUAL WRITING, INSTRUCTION, AND EVERYDAY CONVERSATION WHERE CLARITY AND PRECISION ARE ESSENTIAL. FOR INSTANCE, THE STATEMENT "THE SKY IS BLUE" IS A LITERAL DESCRIPTION, CONVEYING CLEAR, UNAMBIGUOUS INFORMATION WITHOUT ANY HIDDEN OR SYMBOLIC MEANING.

TYPES OF FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE

FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE ENCOMPASSES A BROAD RANGE OF LITERARY DEVICES THAT ENHANCE EXPRESSION AND MEANING. - **ALLITERATION:** REPETITION OF CONSONANT SOUNDS AT THE BEGINNING OF WORDS (E.G., "SHE SELLS SEASHELLS BY THE SEASHORE").
- **ONOMATOPOEIA:** WORDS THAT IMITATE SOUNDS (E.G., "BUZZ," "CLANG").
- **IDIOMS:** PHRASES WITH MEANINGS DIFFERENT FROM THE LITERAL INTERPRETATION (E.G., "BREAK THE ICE").

FUNCTION OF FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE

THE PRIMARY FUNCTION OF FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE IS TO CREATE IMAGERY AND EMOTIONAL RESONANCE, MAKING COMMUNICATION MORE ENGAGING AND MEMORABLE. CHARACTERISTICS OF LITERAL LANGUAGE

EXAMPLES OF LITERAL LANGUAGE

EXAMPLES OF LITERAL LANGUAGE INCLUDE SENTENCES LIKE "THE CAR IS RED," "WATER FREEZES AT 32 DEGREES FAHRENHEIT," OR "SHE WROTE A LETTER." IN ALL THESE CASES, THE MEANING IS CONCRETE, FACTUAL, AND REQUIRES NO INTERPRETATION BEYOND THE WORDS THEMSELVES.

INTERPLAY BETWEEN FIGURATIVE AND LITERAL LANGUAGE
